THE IMPACT OF THE NATIONAL FOOD SECURITY ACT

Quality data drives better policy outcomes – NFSA in numbers

COVERAGE

NFSA provides subsidized food grains to ~81 crore people across India (2023).

STATE-WISE REACH

Goa: 100% of eligible households are covered, ensuring food security for all residents

NUTRITIONAL SUPPORT

Under TPDS, each eligible person receives 5 kg of grain per month at highly subsidized rates, making food accessible and affordable

IMPACT ON MALNUTRITION

Child malnutrition in NFSA states decreased by ~8% from 2013 to 2023, showing real improvements in nutrition

Why Data Matters

Tracking health indicators ensures programs reach the right people and saves lives



Impact in Numbers

- Full child vaccination rose 20% in 10 years

- Over 1.2 million lives impacted across India
