Description of the Program/activity/event	• The Constitution Day Celebration at MPSLGPP was conducted in accordance with directives received from the Directorate of Higher Education, General Administration Department, and Ministries of the Government of India. • The event began with the Mass Reading of the Preamble at 11:00 a.m., where all faculty members, students, and staff assembled to collectively reaffirm their commitment to constitutional ideals. • An Exhibition on Art and Calligraphy in the Constitution of India was displayed using the materials provided through the official campaign website. The exhibition showcased the intricate calligraphy, aesthetic layout, and artistic illustrations in the original handwritten Constitution, giving participants a unique insight into the cultural and artistic heritage of India's constitutional manuscript. • A Screening of an official film related to the Constitution and its significance in democratic governance was conducted for the students. • Students were also encouraged to take part in the Online Samvidhan Diwas Quiz through MyGoa.in portal, which tested their knowledge and awareness of constitutional provisions, rights, duties, and India's democratic journey.

Participants collectively revisited the spirit of the Constitution through the mass Preamble reading, strengthening awareness of justice, liberty, equality, and fraternity. 2. The exhibition on art and calligraphy in the Constitution of India helped students appreciate the

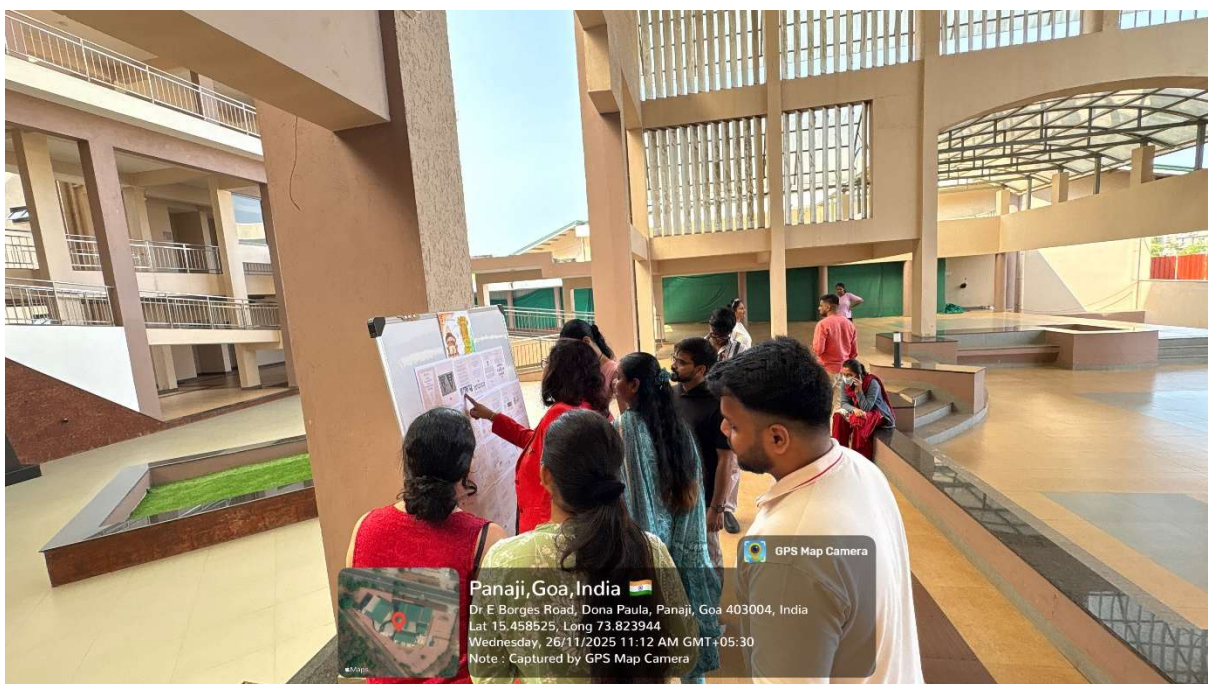

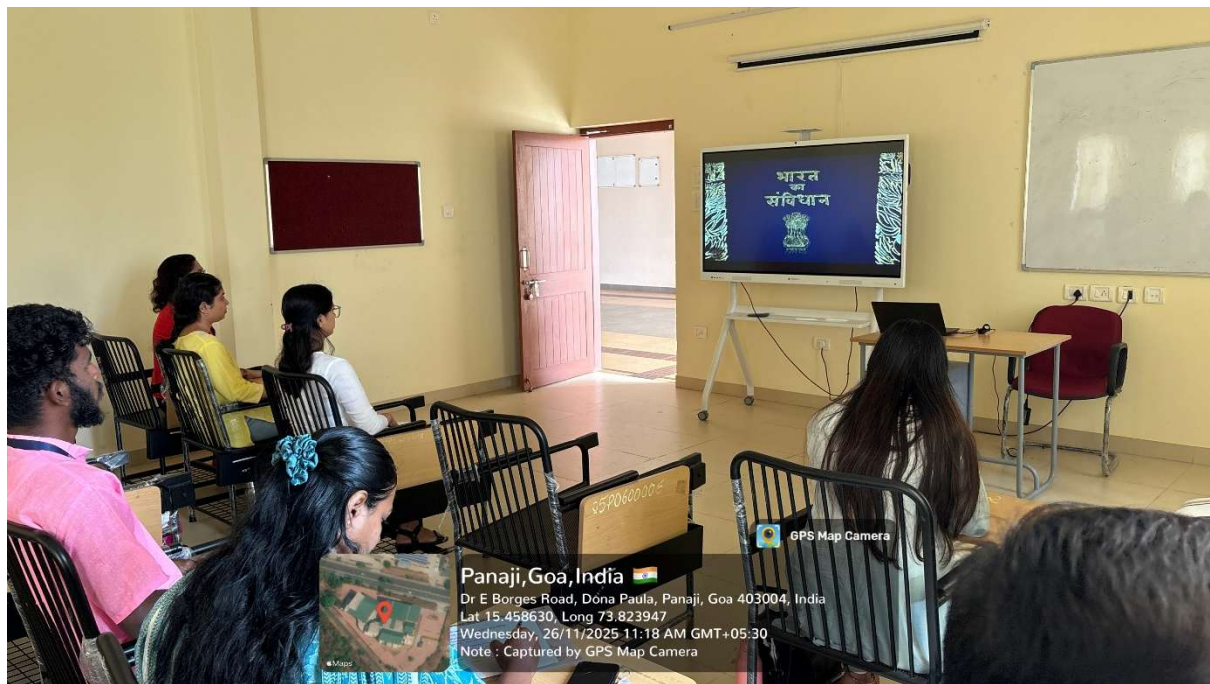




Students and faculty collectively participated in the Mass Preamble Reading held in the MPSLGPP foyer.

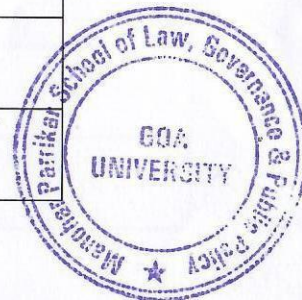
