10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The Workshop on Sanitation Laws and Policies in Goa is designed with the following objectives:

	1. To create awareness and understanding of sanitation-related laws and policies in Goa, including legal obligations of individuals, local bodies, and government authorities. 2. To enhance legal literacy among stakeholders regarding solid waste management, sewage disposal, water pollution control, and public hygiene regulations applicable in the State. 3. To examine the gaps in implementation and enforcement of sanitation laws and identify administrative, infrastructural, and social challenges. 4. To promote community participation and civic responsibility in sanitation initiatives by highlighting the role of citizens, NGOs, and local self-government institutions. 5. To encourage sustainable and eco-friendly sanitation practices aligned with environmental protection norms and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). 6. To develop practical and Goa-specific policy recommendations for strengthening sanitation governance, accountability, and service delivery.

Description of the Program/activity/event	The Workshop on Sanitation Laws and Policies in Goa is a one-day capacity-building and awareness program aimed at addressing critical sanitation challenges through a legal and policy-oriented approach. The workshop will provide a comprehensive overview of existing sanitation laws, rules, and policy frameworks governing waste management, sewage treatment, water conservation, and public hygiene in Goa. The program will feature expert sessions, interactive discussions, and case-based learning, focusing on key issues such as solid waste management rules, wastewater treatment norms, open defecation, public toilet infrastructure, and the statutory responsibilities of municipal bodies and Panchayats. Special emphasis will be placed on Goa's unique ecological sensitivity, tourism-driven pressures, and urban-rural sanitation disparities. Participants, including government officials, legal professionals, academicians, environmental experts, community leaders, and civil society representatives, will engage in dialogue to identify enforcement challenges and best practices. The workshop will also explore innovative sanitation solutions and sustainable models suitable for Goa's socio-economic and environmental context. By integrating legal perspectives with community engagement and governance mechanisms, the program seeks to bridge the gap between law and practice, ultimately contributing to improved sanitation outcomes and public health in the State.

Participants will acquire in-depth knowledge of sanitation laws and policies, enabling better compliance, monitoring, and advocacy for lawful sanitation practices. 2. The program will foster a sense of shared responsibility among citizens and local institutions, encouraging active participation in sanitation and hygiene initiatives. 3. Deliberations during the workshop will generate actionable recommendations to improve sanitation infrastructure, enforcement mechanisms, and governance effectiveness. 4. The workshop will highlight environmentally sustainable practices such as waste segregation, recycling, waste-to-energy models, and decentralized wastewater treatment systems. 5. Improved sanitation practices will contribute to reduced health risks, cleaner surroundings, and enhanced environmental protection across Goa. 6. The workshop will facilitate collaboration among policymakers, legal experts, environmentalists, and community leaders, ensuring a coordinated approach to sanitation challenges. 7. 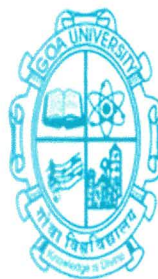

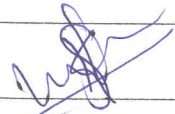
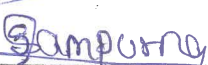
