The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The Workshop on Workshop on Safeguarding Children from Abuse: Awareness, Prevention and Legal Responsibilities is designed with the following objectives: 1. To promote legal literacy on child protection by creating awareness about “Good Touch” and “Bad Touch” in accordance with national child safety and welfare frameworks. 2. To sensitize children, parents, teachers, and guardians on child abuse prevention, focusing on personal safety, bodily autonomy, and age-appropriate understanding of boundaries. 3. To disseminate knowledge of child protection laws, particularly the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012, as part of community-oriented legal awareness initiatives. 4. To empower children with basic self-protection skills and encourage help-seeking behavior through trusted institutional and community support systems. 5. To encourage community participation and stakeholder engagement in child safety initiatives in line with NSS objectives of social service, civic responsibility, and inclusive development. 6. To contribute towards creating a safe, child-friendly environment by addressing social stigma and promoting open dialogue on child rights and protection mechanisms.



11. Description of the Program/activity/event	Workshop On Safeguarding Children From Abuse: Awareness, Prevention And Legal Responsibilities is designed to educate, protect, and empower children by creating a safe and informed environment where they can understand personal boundaries and recognize inappropriate behaviour. The programme addresses the growing concern of child sexual abuse, which often remains hidden due to fear, lack of awareness, and social stigma. This activity focuses on helping children clearly distinguish between safe (good) touch and unsafe (bad) touch through age-appropriate explanations, interactive discussions, and practical examples. Special emphasis is placed on teaching children that their body belongs to them and that they have the right to say “no” to any touch that makes them uncomfortable, regardless of who the person is. The programme also sensitizes parents, teachers, and caregivers about their crucial role in preventing child abuse. It provides guidance on how to communicate openly with children, identify early warning signs of abuse, and respond appropriately if a child discloses an incident. Awareness of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 is incorporated to ensure adults understand their legal responsibilities, including mandatory reporting and child-friendly procedures. Through awareness sessions, storytelling, visual aids, and simple safety rules, the programme aims to build children’s confidence to speak up, seek help from trusted adults, and report unsafe situations without fear or shame. By encouraging open dialogue and reducing taboos surrounding child abuse, the programme contributes to creating a safer, more responsive community committed to the protection and well-being of every child.

12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	1. Early Identification of Abuse: Children will develop the ability to recognize inappropriate behavior at an early stage, enabling timely disclosure and prevention of prolonged abuse. 2. Clear Understanding of Body Boundaries: Through age-appropriate learning on “Good Touch” and “Bad Touch,” children will understand personal boundaries and bodily autonomy, which is crucial for self-protection. Increased Reporting and Help-Seeking Behavior: The programme will encourage children to speak up without fear or shame and identify trusted adults, helplines, and authorities for seeking help in cases of abuse. 3. Enhanced Parental and Teacher Responsiveness: Parents, guardians, and educators will be better equipped to observe behavioral changes, respond sensitively to disclosures, and take lawful and supportive action. 4. Awareness of Legal Protection Mechanisms: Participants will gain practical knowledge of child-specific legal safeguards, especially the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, ensuring lawful handling and reporting of cases. 5. Reduction in Silence and Stigma: Open discussion of child abuse will help dismantle myths, fear, and social stigma, fostering a culture where children’s voices are respected and believed. 6. Prevention-Focused Mindset: The programme shifts the approach from reaction to prevention by promoting safe environments at home, school, and in the community. 7. Strengthening Child Confidence and Self-Esteem: By understanding their rights and safety, children will gain confidence to assert

	boundaries and resist coercion or manipulation. 8. Community-Level Child Protection Awareness: The workshop will promote collective responsibility among community members to safeguard children and report abuse promptly. 9. Long-Term Psychological Safety: Early awareness and intervention reduce the risk of long-term emotional trauma, contributing to healthier mental and emotional development of children.
