The objectives of the Program/activity/event	Workshop On “Drug Abuse: Legal Implications and Social Impact.” has the following objectives: To create legal awareness on drug abuse and illicit trafficking To educate participants about the legal framework governing drug abuse and trafficking, with special reference to the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, allied laws, and relevant international conventions. To sensitize participants to the social and security implications of drug abuse To highlight how drug abuse adversely affects public health, family structures, social order, and national security by fueling organized and transnational crime. To enhance understanding of penalties and legal consequences To inform students, youth, and community members about the severe criminal liabilities, punishments, and long-term consequences associated with drug consumption, possession, and trafficking. To strengthen preventive and community-based approaches

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	To promote awareness of preventive strategies, including education, early intervention, and community vigilance, as effective tools to curb drug abuse at the grassroots level. 5. To examine challenges in law enforcement and prosecution To discuss practical difficulties faced by law enforcement agencies in investigation, evidence collection, prosecution, and inter-agency coordination under the NDPS regime. 6. To promote coordination among stakeholders To foster collaboration between legal professionals, law enforcement authorities, educators, policymakers, and community leaders for a coordinated response to drug-related crimes. 7. To emphasize rehabilitation and reintegration of drug users To underscore the importance of treatment, counseling, and rehabilitation mechanisms for drug-dependent individuals, in line with a reformative and human-rights-oriented approach. 8. To empower youth and communities as agents of change To encourage informed participation of youth and community members in reporting drug trafficking, resisting substance abuse, and promoting a drug-free environment. 9. To bridge the gap between law, enforcement, and social responsibility To promote a balanced approach that combines strict legal enforcement with social awareness, victim support, and preventive education.
11. Description of the Program/activity/event	The Workshop on “Drug Abuse: Legal Implications and Social Impact” is designed as an awareness-cum-capacity-building programme aimed at addressing the growing menace of drug abuse and illicit trafficking

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through a legal and social lens. The workshop seeks to sensitize participants to the serious legal consequences of drug-related offences while also examining the broader social, economic, and psychological impacts on individuals, families, and society at large.

The programme focuses on providing a comprehensive understanding of the **legal framework governing drug abuse and trafficking**, particularly the provisions of the **Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, 1985**, along with relevant international conventions and enforcement mechanisms. Through expert sessions, the workshop explains offences, penalties, procedural safeguards, and the role of investigating agencies, thereby bridging the gap between law in theory and law in practice.

In addition to legal awareness, the workshop addresses the **social dimensions of drug abuse**, including its impact on youth, public health, family structures, and community safety. Special emphasis is placed on the link between drug abuse and organized crime, highlighting how illicit trafficking undermines national security and fuels other criminal activities. Participants are encouraged to understand drug abuse not merely as an individual failing, but as a complex social problem requiring collective responsibility.

The Workshop also highlights **preventive strategies and rehabilitation mechanisms**, stressing the importance of education, early intervention, counselling, and community participation. Discussions on de-addiction, rehabilitation, and reintegration aim to promote a balanced approach that combines strict legal enforcement with compassion and victim-centric support systems.
