The objectives of the Program/activity/event	Workshop on Exploring the Intersection of Law and Society theme on Enhancing Access to Justice: Promoting Women's Health Rights and Legal Empowerment has the following objectives: 1. To Promote Legal Awareness among Women To educate women, particularly from marginalized and vulnerable communities, about their legal rights relating to health, gender equality, and protection against discrimination and violence. 2. To Strengthen Access to Justice Mechanisms To enhance understanding of available legal remedies, institutions, and procedures that enable women to seek justice in matters related to health rights and gender-based violations. 3. To Address Barriers in Healthcare Access To identify and analyze socio-economic, cultural, and institutional barriers that prevent women from accessing adequate healthcare services and legal support. 4. To Raise Awareness on Gender-Based Violence and Legal Protections To sensitize participants about various forms of gender-based



violence and the legal frameworks available for prevention, protection, and redressal.

5. To Foster Interdisciplinary Collaboration

To create a platform for dialogue and cooperation among legal professionals, healthcare providers, policymakers, and community stakeholders for a coordinated approach to women's empowerment.

6. To Enhance Advocacy and Capacity Building

To equip participants with practical tools and strategies for community advocacy, enabling them to promote legal literacy, health rights, and gender justice.

Description of the Program/activity/event	The workshop on “<i>Enhancing Access to Justice: Promoting Women’s Health Rights and Legal Empowerment</i>” is designed as an interdisciplinary and participatory initiative aimed at addressing the critical intersection between law, health, and gender justice. The programme seeks to create a platform where legal awareness, healthcare access, and women’s empowerment converge to promote equitable and inclusive development. The workshop focuses on strengthening access to justice by equipping participants—particularly women from marginalized and vulnerable communities—with knowledge of their legal rights related to health, bodily autonomy, and protection from discrimination and violence. It emphasizes the importance of legal literacy as a tool for empowerment, enabling women to recognize violations of their rights and seek appropriate remedies through legal mechanisms. Through expert-led sessions, interactive discussions, and case-based learning, the programme explores key issues such as barriers to healthcare access, gender-based violence, socio-economic inequalities, and gaps in the implementation of existing legal frameworks. Participants are introduced to relevant laws, policies, and institutional mechanisms that safeguard women’s rights, while also critically examining the challenges in their enforcement. The workshop adopts a multi-stakeholder approach by bringing together legal practitioners, healthcare professionals, social workers, academicians, and community representatives. This collaborative environment encourages dialogue, knowledge-sharing, and the development of practical strategies to address systemic issues affecting women’s health and justice. Additionally, the programme places strong emphasis on capacity-building and advocacy. It aims to empower participants with skills to engage in community outreach, promote awareness, and contribute to policy discussions. By fostering leadership among women and encouraging collective action, the workshop aspires to create sustainable impact at both grassroots and institutional levels. Overall, the programme serves as a catalyst for bridging the gap between legal rights and their realization in everyday life, promoting

	accountability, and advancing the broader goals of gender equality, health equity, and social justice.

Development of Policy Recommendations The insights generated during the workshop will help formulate practical and actionable recommendations aimed at

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	strengthening legal frameworks, improving service delivery, and ensuring accountability in protecting women's rights. 7. Promotion of Gender-Sensitive Approaches Participants will be sensitized to adopt gender-responsive practices in legal and healthcare systems, ensuring that services are more inclusive, accessible, and responsive to women's needs. 8. Emergence of Women Leaders and Change Agents The workshop will identify and encourage women leaders who can act as catalysts for change, promoting legal literacy and health rights within their communities and sustaining long-term impact.
