CIRCULAR

University Scholarship applications are invited via Online mode from eligible Undergraduate, Post Graduate, Post Graduate Diploma Students enrolled in various Schools on the University Campus for the Award of Merit Scholarship, Free Studentship and Student Aid Fund for the Academic Year 2026-27.

The eligibility criteria for Merit Scholarship, Free Studentship and Student Aid Fund are as follows:

a. MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

1. A candidate at the qualifying examination should have secured at least 65% of aggregate marks.

b. FREE STUDENTSHIP

1. The applicant's annual income should not exceed **Rs. 3,00,000/- per annum** for the Financial Year 2025-26.
2. The candidate should have secured at least 45% of aggregate marks in the last qualifying examination with no backlog.
3. The applicant should be a resident of Goa for 15 years.

c. STUDENT AID FUND

1. The applicant's annual income should not exceed **Rs. 1,50,000/- per annum** for the Financial Year 2025-26.
2. The candidate should not have any backlog in his/her qualifying examination.
3. The applicant should be a resident of Goa for 15 years.

The documents required for availing Merit Scholarship, Free Studentship and Student Aid Fund are as follows:

MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

- a. Marksheets of both the semesters (odd & even) of the qualifying examination for the Academic Year **2025-26**. In case the programmes has only one semester, the candidate may submit the self-attested marksheet of Semester I of the Academic Year **2025-26**. If the student has taken a gap in his/ her studies in the Academic Year 2025-26, then he/she will submit the marksheets of the last qualifying year.
- b. First page of the applicant's bank passbook/ Cancelled cheque/ bank mandate form duly signed by the Bank Official.
- c. Fee receipt for the Academic Year 2026-27.

FREE STUDENTSHIP

- a. Marksheets of both the semesters (odd & even) of the qualifying examination for the Academic Year **2025-26**. In case the programmes has only one semester, the candidate may submit the self-attested marksheet of semester I of the Academic Year **2025-26**. If the student has taken a gap in his/ her studies in the Academic Year 2025-26, then he/she will submit the marksheets of the last qualifying year.
- b. Family Income Certificate of the Financial Year, i.e. **2025-26** which should be less than or equal to Rs. 3,00,000/- (only family income certificate will be considered and not the individual income certificate).
- c. First page of the applicant's Bank passbook/ Cancelled Cheque/ Bank Mandate form duly signed by the Bank Official.
- d. A copy of Ration Card.
- e. Residence Certificate of 15 years issued by the Mamlatdar of the concerned taluka.
- f. Fee receipt of the Academic Year 2026-27.

STUDENT AID FUND

- a. Marksheets of both the semesters (odd & even) of the qualifying examination for the Academic Year **2025-26**. In case the programmes has only one semester, the candidate may submit the self-attested marksheet of Semester I of the Academic Year **2025-26**. If the

student has taken a gap in his/ her studies in the Academic Year 2025-26, then he/she will submit the marksheets of the last qualifying year.

- b. Family Income Certificate of the Financial Year, i.e. **2025-26** which should be less than or equal to Rs. 1,50,000/- (only family income certificate will be considered and not the individual income certificate).
- c. First page of the applicant's Bank passbook/ Cancelled Cheque/ Bank Mandate form duly signed by the Bank Official.
- d. A copy of ration Card.
- e. Residence Certificate of 15 years issued by the Mamlatdar of the concerned taluka.
- f. Fee receipt of the Academic Year 2026-27.

In case the marks of the student are not stated on the marksheets uploaded by the student for the Academic Year 2025-26, then the student is required to upload the self-attested document of calculation of marks obtained under the CGPA (The document should consist of Total obtained marks and Total marks (Out of) per semester). The format for uploading the self-attested document is at Annexure I.

Students who are working professionals are not eligible to apply for the Merit Scholarship/ Free Studentship/ Student Aid Fund.

Those students availing the benefits under any other Schemes/ Scholarships shall not be eligible to avail similar benefits under the Goa University Scholarships. The students would, however, be permitted to exercise their choice of the Schemes/ Scholarships to avail similar benefits.

Students are allowed to apply for only one Scholarship, i.e. Merit Scholarship or Free Studentship or Student Aid Fund.

Candidates should note that the documents such as Bank details, Marksheets, Income Certificate, Residence Certificate, Fee Receipt and Ration Card should be correct/valid. Incomplete applications without correct/valid documents shall be rejected.

The students who are interested in applying for the Merit Scholarship or Free Studentship or Student Aid Fund shall fill the prescribed Online Scholarship application and submit the application complete in all respects along with the necessary documents (Refer Annexure -II and Instructions indicated in the Online application).

The last date for students to submit the Online Scholarship application is **31/08/2026.**

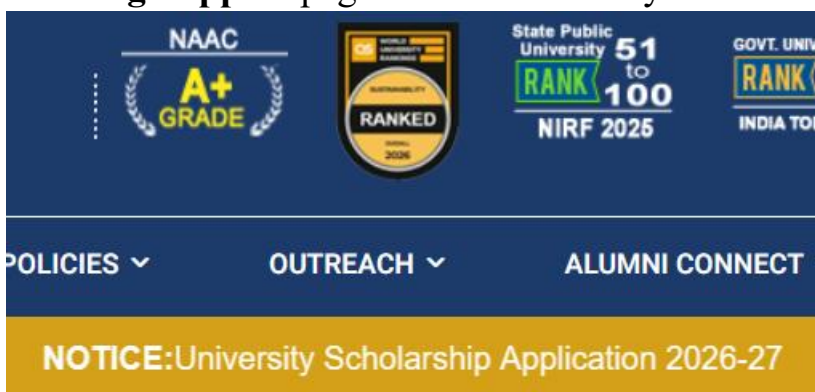
