The Discipline of French and Francophone Studies at Goa University celebrated Bastille Day, the National Day of France, on July 14, 2026. This student-led event aimed to highlight the day's history while bringing the French language and culture to life on campus.

Commonly referred to as *Le 14 Juillet* or *La Fête Nationale* in French, the date marks two major milestones of the French Revolution: the 1789 storming of the Bastille prison, which signaled the end of the absolute monarchy, and the Fête de la Fédération in 1790, which established many symbols of the modern French Republic.

The celebrations began with a presentation mapping out these historic origins and tracing how the events of July 14th shaped modern France and its traditions. Moving beyond theory, the students participated in a French Revolution-inspired scavenger hunt. Teams representing the historic 'Three Estates' raced to solve cultural clues and riddles, testing both their quick thinking and teamwork. This was followed by an interactive quiz focused on French history and language.

The afternoon concluded with a community potluck. Faculty and students shared dishes in a casual setting, offering a relaxed environment for conversation and cultural exchange.

The initiative highlighted the discipline's focus on learning the French language outside the traditional classroom.

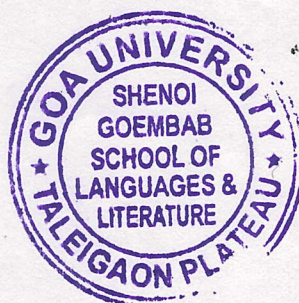
