'Partition Horrors Remembrance Day Exhibition' was held on 10 August 2026 in BG-47 classroom from 10:00 a.m. onwards to 5:00 p.m. It was organized by Discipline of History, D.D. Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies in collaboration with N.S.S Unit of Goa University. Prof. Harilal B. Menon, Vice- Chancellor, Goa University visited the exhibition. The Exhibition was inaugurated by Prof. Sunder Dhuri, Registrar, Goa University in presence of Prof. Nagendra Rao, Dean, D. D. Kosambi School of Social Sciences and Behavioural Studies, Dr. Nitin Sawant, Shri. Vinod Kankonkar and Dr. Nalini Naik. 51 students attended the exhibition along with 05 external faculty.

Objectives of organizing this exhibition on Partition Horrors Remembrance Day was:

- To foster patriotism, national unity and greater public awareness, particularly among youth.
- To commemorate the victims of Partition — honour those who lost their lives, homes, livelihoods, and loved ones during the Partition of 1947.

- To encourage historical reflection — provide an opportunity to examine Partition critically and understand its continuing social and cultural impact.

CIRCULAR

5. Organize exhibitions/displays highlighting India's freedom movement, national heritage, and the significance of Vande Mataram @150.
6. Conduct awareness programmes for students on Har Ghar Tiranga 2026 and Partition Horrors Remembrance Day.
