10. The objectives of the Program/activity/event	The objective of the conference was to foster collaboration and innovation by integrating India's rich heritage of knowledge with modern scientific advancements. By focusing on thematic areas such as biodiversity conservation, One Health & One Nation, Indian Knowledge Systems, Made in India technology, nano and omics, renewable energy, and computational biology, the program aimed to create a platform for academia, research institutions, and industry to share insights.
11. Description of the Program/activity/event	The conference was designed as a dynamic platform bridging traditional wisdom and modern science to address contemporary challenges in health management and sustainable resource utilization. Rooted in the Indian Knowledge System (IKS), the programme integrated traditional insights into ecology, medicine, and sustainability with advancements in biotechnology, omics, nanotechnology, and artificial intelligence. Keynote lectures, invited talks, panel discussions, and interactive sessions facilitated dialogue among traditional practitioners, researchers, technologists, and scientists, while promoting interdisciplinary research, collaborations, and innovation-driven solutions. Day 1 – 21 January 2026 The conference commenced with an inaugural ceremony featuring an invocation song by students of SBSB, followed by the welcome address delivered by Sr. Prof. Sanjeev Ghadi, Vice-Dean Academics, SBSB. He highlighted the significance of biodiversity and innovation in addressing global challenges. The floral welcome and ceremonial lighting of the traditional lamp marked the formal inauguration. Dr. Meghanath Prabhu, Organizing Secretary, introduced the conference theme and objectives, emphasizing interdisciplinary research and translational outcomes. The Abstract Book was subsequently released. Addresses by Sr. Prof. S. Krishnan, Dean, SBSB, and the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Goa University, Prof. (HAG) Harilal B. Menon, highlighted the role of universities in

fostering innovation-driven ecosystems.

The Inaugural Address by Chief Guest Prof. Ashutosh Sharma, Former President of INSA, emphasized scientific innovation, policy support, and entrepreneurship for national development.

The first two technical sessions, themed "One Health & One Nation," featured a keynote lecture by Prof. Mrutyunjay Suar on innovation and entrepreneurship-driven ecosystems. Invited lectures by Prof. (Dr.) Sujata Kadam, Dr. Harsh Sheth, Dr. Arnab Banerjee, and Dr. Nareshkumar Jain covered Ayurveda-based One Health perspectives, genomics in disease prevention, reproductive biology, and antibody–drug conjugates. Oral and poster presentations showcased research by students and young researchers from across the country. The day concluded with a cultural programme and dinner, facilitating informal interactions and networking.

Day 2 – 22 January 2026

The second day featured sessions on Indian Knowledge Systems and Made-in-India Technology. The keynote lecture by Dr. D. Narasimhan focused on people-friendly ethnobotany, community participation, and conservation ethics. Invited lectures by Dr. Latika Dawara and Mr. Varad Samant addressed public health-oriented patent systems and sustainable agricultural innovations, respectively.

The post-lunch session on Nano and Omics Technology featured lectures by Prof. Neel Sarovar Bhavesh, Dr. Jitendra Thakur, Dr. Imran Uddin, and Dr. Khurshed A. Shah, highlighting Ayurveda-based omics, antifungal resistance, nature-inspired nanomaterials, and biosensor development. Oral presentation sessions further encouraged scientific exchange and constructive feedback among young researchers.

Day 3 – 23 January 2026

The final day addressed the themes of Biodiversity and Conservation, Renewable Energy, and Computational Biology and Artificial Intelligence.

The keynote lecture by Shri C. Achalender Reddy, former Chairman of the National Biodiversity Authority, provided insights into biodiversity conservation challenges and opportunities in India. Invited lectures by Prof. C. R. K. Reddy and Dr. Keshav Prasad explored seaweed-based innovations, startup opportunities, and AI-driven integrative omics for One Health applications.

A special session titled "Bio-InnoQuest" promoted innovative thinking and entrepreneurship among young scientists. The concluding technical session featured lectures by Dr. Sukanta Mondal and Dr. Raghavendra Gaud on computational biology, biomarker discovery, and the transformative potential of bio-innovation in healthcare and agriculture.

Conference Highlights and Valedictory Function

Over three days, the conference featured 3 keynote lectures, 14 invited lectures, 30 oral presentations, 48 poster presentations,

	and 12 Bio-InnoQuest presentations, with active participation from academicians, researchers, faculty members, industry professionals, and students from across the country. The conference successfully achieved its objective of integrating biodiversity, bio-innovation, traditional knowledge, and modern technologies to address national and global challenges while fostering interdisciplinary collaboration and innovation. The conference concluded with a Valedictory Function held in the august presence of Shri Subhash Ankush Shirodkar, Hon'ble Minister for Water Resources, Cooperation and Provedoria, Government of Goa, and Prof. Sundar Dhuri, Registrar, Goa University.
12. Benefit/Key outcomes of the Program/activity/event	The conference generated transformative outcomes by successfully bridging the Indian Knowledge System (IKS) with modern scientific advancements. The keynote lectures, invited lectures, oral presentations, poster presentations, and bio-innoquest presentations, witnessed active participation from academicians, researchers, faculty, industry professionals, and students from across the country. The participants found it as wonderful experience, as they got a chance to interact with innovative minds, and it served as great source of information and inspired them to try to reach out to other fields. The participants enjoyed the food and the cultural programme. The invited lectures were both engaging and insightful. Annexure II* (Brief Biodata of the resource persons)

1) Ashutosh Sharma

Ashutosh Sharma is Institute Chair Professor at IIT Kanpur, President of the Indian National Science Academy (2023-). He served as Co-chair of S20/G20 (2023) and a former Secretary to the Government of India heading its Department of Science and Technology (2015- 2021). He was a Professor and the Head (2003-05) of Chemical Engineering, and the founding Coordinator of Nanosciences Center and Advanced Imaging Center at the Indian Institute of Technology at Kanpur.

2) Dr. Mrutyunjay Suar

Entrepreneurial professor with Master's in Marine Biotechnology from Goa University, PhD in Molecular Microbiology from University of Delhi in 2003 and Postdoc at ETH Zurich, Switzerland. He returned to India and established the School of Biotechnology in 2007 under KIIT University in Bhubaneswar.

3) Prof. Sujata D. Kadam

Prof. Sujata D. Kadam is a senior academician, clinician, and administrator with over 29 years of experience in teaching, research, and clinical practice in Ayurveda. She is currently serving as Dean (Academic & Administration), All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), Goa, and Head of Department (Prasuti Tantra & Streerog) at AIIA, New Delhi and Goa. She has also been officially entrusted with the additional charge of Director (I/c), AIIA since November 2025. She holds degrees of B.A.M.S., M.S. (Prasuti Tantra & Streerog), and Ph.D. in Prasuti Tantra. With extensive leadership experience, she has served as Dean at AIIA New Delhi for 5 years and Dean at AIIA Goa for 2.5 years, and as HoD for over 22 years at reputed institutions. Prof. Kadam is a recognized Ph.D. guide across three universities, having supervised 56 postgraduate students and 11 Ph.D. scholars.

4) Dr. Harsh Sheth

Dr. Harsh Sheth, Ph.D. (Translational Genetics, Newcastle University, UK) is an accomplished geneticist and translational researcher with expertise in next-generation sequencing (NGS), long-read sequencing, computational biology, cancer prevention, male infertility, rare disease diagnostics, molecular epidemiology, and personalised medicine. Dr. Sheth has secured 25 research grants and scholarships since 2008, with cumulative funding exceeding ₹8 crores, supported by national and international agencies including ICMR, UK Medical Research Council, Wellcome Trust, Gujarat State Biotech Mission, Bristol-Myers Squibb–Pfizer Alliance, and New York Academy of Sciences, among others. He has authored 46 peer-reviewed international publications, 3 book chapters, 1 technology white paper, and holds 1 worldwide patent on an NGS-based MSI assay along with 2 national patents on smMIP-based SNV and CNV detection. He is an active member of leading professional bodies such as ASCO, ASHG, ESHG, NYAS, and ISHG, and has served as a panel member for South Africa's Open Genome Project, ICMR's Sub-Committee on Precision Oncology, and ISMPO Rectal Cancer Guidelines.

5) Dr. Arnab Banerjee

Dr. Arnab Banerjee is an Associate Professor of Zoology at Banaras Hindu University (BHU), Varanasi, with over a decade of experience in teaching, research, and academic leadership in reproductive biology, endocrinology, and developmental physiology. He previously served as Associate Professor and Assistant Professor at the Department of Biological Sciences, BITS Pilani, K. K. Birla Goa Campus.

6) Dr. Nareshkumar Jain

Dr. Jain is the Founder and CEO of NJ Bio, Inc., a premier CRO/CDMO with a strong focus on antibody-drug conjugates (ADCs), antibody-oligonucleotide conjugates (AOCs), mRNA, siRNA, and other nucleic acid-based therapeutics. He has led numerous programs involving complex bioconjugation, linker-payload design, oligonucleotide conjugation, and GMP manufacturing. He also founded The Chemistry Research Solution (TCRS), acquired by Abzena in 2015, and spent over a decade in medicinal chemistry roles at Johnson & Johnson.

7) Dr. D. Narasimhan

Dr. D. Narasimhan is a retired Associate Professor of Plant Biology and Plant Biotechnology from Madras Christian College, Chennai, and a renowned expert in plant taxonomy, biodiversity conservation, and ethnobotany. He holds a Ph.D. in Plant Taxonomy from the University of Madras, along with M.Sc. and M.Phil. degrees in Botany from Madras Christian College. Dr. Narasimhan currently serves as a Member of the Expert Committee on Access and Benefit Sharing (ABS) of the National Biodiversity Authority, Chennai, and has also contributed to the Tamil Nadu State Biodiversity Board and various advisory bodies related to biodiversity policy, conservation education, and traditional knowledge systems.

8) Dr. Latika Dawara

Dr. Latika Dawara is an Assistant Controller of Patents & Designs at the Patent Office, Mumbai, with a PhD in Chemistry and CSIR-NET (JRF) qualification. She has 14 years of experience in patent examination of pharmaceutical and chemistry-related inventions and is Group Leader, Chemistry Group (since July 2023). She has extensive expertise in FERs, hearings, oppositions, and decisions on grant/refusal under the Indian Patents Act. Her landmark decision rejecting J&J's bedaquiline patent significantly advanced public health access in 134 low- and middle-income countries. She is an internationally recognized expert, invited by WHO and represented India in global patent examination workshops.

9) Varad Nagesh Samant

Varad Nagesh Samant, a 29-year-old progressive farmer from Dharbandora, Goa, is a B. Com graduate who began his agricultural journey at the age of 24. Starting with bhendi cultivation on a 2000 sq. m area, he gradually diversified into crops such as cucumber, cabbage, chilli, watermelon, alsande, and floriculture (marigold and rose). Challenging the common belief that carrots cannot be grown in Goa, he successfully cultivated carrots through scientific study and practical knowledge—marking a major turning point in his farming career. Driven by innovation and sustainability, he aspires to inspire at least ten more youths like himself to take up agriculture and contribute to the vision of Swayampurna Goa under Hon'ble CM Dr. Pramod Sawant and Atmanirbhar Bharat of the Hon'ble Prime Minister.

10) Prof. Neel Sarovar Bhavesh

Prof. Neel Sarovar Bhavesh is a Physical Chemist who obtained his PhD from TIFR, Mumbai (2003), specializing in protein and nucleic acid NMR spectroscopy. He developed landmark 3D triple-resonance NMR pulse sequences (HNN, HN(C)N) and discovered a novel C-tetrad in DNA quadruplexes. He received the TAA-Zita Lobo Memorial Award and an IUPAC Prize Honourable Mention for his PhD research. Prof. Bhavesh carried out postdoctoral research with Nobel Laureate Prof. Kurt Wüthrich at ETH Zürich. Since 2008, he has been a Group Leader at ICGEB, New Delhi, and played a key role in establishing high-field NMR facilities at ICGEB and NII.

11) Dr. Jitendra Thakur

Dr. Jitendra Thakur joined ICGEB New Delhi following an eleven years stint as a Scientist at the NIPGR, New Delhi. Earlier, Jitendra was an Assistant Professor at IISER-Kolkata. He earned his M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Plant Molecular Biology from University of Delhi South Campus and then got postdoctoral training at Harvard Medical School/MGH Cancer Center, Boston, USA. He has got several prestigious awards and fellowships including NASI-Reliance Industries Platinum Jubilee Award, INSA Young Scientist Medal, Innovative Young Biotechnologist Award of Department of Biotechnology, Prof Archana Sharma Memorial Award of Indian Science Congress and Fellowship for Medical Discovery from Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston. He has been elected as a Fellow of The National Academy of Sciences, India.

12) Prof. Imran Uddin

Prof. Imran Uddin is a Professor at Saveetha Institute of Medical and Technical Sciences (SIMATS), Chennai, India. He earned his Ph.D. in Biotechnology from CSIR–National Chemical Laboratory, Pune, and an M.Sc. in Marine Biotechnology from Goa University. He has held research and academic positions internationally, including Senior Research Scientist at the University of Pannonia, Hungary, Postdoctoral Fellow at Rhodes University (South Africa) and Korea University (Republic of Korea), and Assistant Professor at Aligarh Muslim University, Aligarh.

13) Dr. Khurshed Ahmad Shah

Dr. Khurshed Ahmad Shah is an Associate Professor in the PG Department of Physics, Sri Pratap College, School of Sciences, Cluster University Srinagar, Jammu & Kashmir, India. He holds M.Phil. and Ph.D. degrees in Physics and is a Fellow of the Institute of Physics (IOP), London, and a Member of the National Academy of Sciences (MNAs).

14) Mr. C. Achalender Reddy

Mr. C. Achalender Reddy is a 1986 batch Indian Forest Service officer who retired at the level of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (PCCF), Arunachal Pradesh. He assumed charge as Chairperson, National Biodiversity Authority (NBA) on 01 December 2022 at Chennai. Hailing from a farming family in Yerragollapahad village, Jangaon district, Telangana, Mr. Reddy is an alumnus of Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University, Hyderabad. He has over 34 years of distinguished service in the AGMUT cadre, serving in Arunachal Pradesh, Goa, Mizoram, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, and Andhra Pradesh in various leadership positions, including Managing Director, Goa Forest Development Corporation, Director, National Bamboo Mission (Goa), and Director, Centre for Innovations in Public Systems (ASCI), Hyderabad.

15) Dr. C. R. K. Reddy

Dr. C. R. K. Reddy, a distinguished scientist in the field of marine macroalgae research and biotechnology. Dr. Reddy currently serves as Head of Business Development (Tropical Seaweeds) at NPPL by UPL, Bangalore, and holds an honorary Adjunct Professorship at the Institute of Chemical Technology (ICT-Mumbai). With over three decades of pioneering work, Dr. Reddy has made significant contributions to seaweed cultivation, bioprocessing, and sustainable utilization,

shaping India's seaweed farming landscape. His illustrious career includes serving as DBT Energy Biosciences Chair Professor at ICT-Mumbai and as Chief Scientist at CSIR-Central Salt & Marine Chemicals Research Institute, where he led transformative research for 25 years.

16) Dr. T. S. Keshava Prasad

Center for Omics & Systems Medicine (C-OSM) | K. S. Hegde Medical Academy (KSHEMA) | Nitte (Deemed to be University) Mangalore. Dr. T. S. Keshava Prasad is a Professor and Director of the Center for Omics & Systems Medicine (C-OSM) at K. S. Hegde Medical Academy (KSHEMA), Nitte (Deemed to be University), Mangalore. He holds a Ph.D. in Botany from Goa University (2004) and is an internationally recognized expert in proteomics, proteogenomics, phosphoproteomics, and metabolomics, with a focus on multi-omics approaches for molecular profiling of human diseases, pathogens, and vectors.

17) Prof. Sukanta Mondal

Dr. Mondal works in the field of bioinformatics and computational biology to address various challenging questions in bio-molecular science. He obtained his Ph.D. degree from Indian Institute of Science, Bengaluru in 2007, under the supervision of Prof. Ramakumar S, for thesis work titled "Contributions to venom informatics: sequence-structure-function studies of toxins from marine cone snails. Gathering rich experience at both national and international levels, he initiated his Annotate Biomolecules Computationally (ABC) research group at BITS Pilani, K. K. Birla Goa campus in the year 2012, which currently has various doctoral, graduate and undergraduate students.

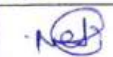
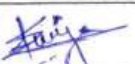
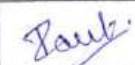
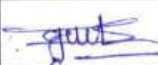
18) Dr. Raghavendra Goud Vaggu

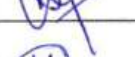
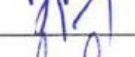
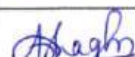
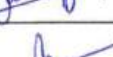
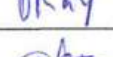
