Please find enclosed herewith the **detailed brochure** regarding Goa University Inter-Collegiate Chess (Mix) Championships 2026-2027 for your kind perusal and further necessary action.

❖ **Chess (Mix)**

- The Inter-Collegiate Chess (Mix) Championship will be held at S.A. G's Multipurpose hall, Peddem, Mapusa-Goa on **1st & 2nd September 2026** from **9.30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.**
- Rules of the All India Chess Federation/ International Chess Federation shall apply to the Inter-College Chess Tournament unless, otherwise, modified in these rules.
- The tournament will be played according to the Swiss Method (Nine rounds & 20 minutes to each player in each round).
- A team may consist of minimum 4 players and maximum 5 players (4 players playing as per given board order in each round & 5th is reserved which can be substituted in next round).
- Each college shall enter the names in the Google form and eligibility as per **1st round Board Order** and **FIDE ID in remark column** if available. The reserve shall be ranked at the bottom.
- In the event of inability of a playing member to participate, the ranking order shall be changed in such a way that only the player following him in the ladder takes his place and so on. No player shall be replaced during the course of the tournament.

Registration & Deadlines

- **Online Entry**(must be filled out and submitted exclusively by the College Director of Physical Education and Sports): Last date to send college entry through Google Form <https://forms.gle/4DzKjrfvjsRbpGv79> is **24/08/2026 latest by 10.00 a.m.**
- **Eligibility Proforma**: Participating teams must submit their eligibility proforma in Excel format via email to icteligibility@unigoa.ac.in no later than **24/08/2026 till 5.00 p.m.**

- **Medical Fitness**: College Directors of Physical Education and Sports are responsible for ensuring all participants are fully fit. Goa University will not collect medical certificates, nor will it be held responsible for any medical complications that arise
