❖ **Cycling for Men**

- The Inter-Collegiate Cycling Championship for Men is scheduled to take place on **09th October 2026** at Rosary College, Navelim-Goa. Participants are required to report by **1:30 p.m.**
- The competition will adhere to the regulations set forth by the Cycling Federation of India, unless specified otherwise in the accompanying rules.
- The number of Athletes for consideration of team participation shall not be less than 4 and more than 9. Individual participation from college remains permissible, and if only 3 athletes are participating, they shall not be recognized as a team for championship purpose.
- The race will cover a distance of 35 kilometers and will commence promptly at 2:30 p.m. All participants are expected to complete the race within a two-hour time frame from the start.

Registration & Deadlines

- **Online Entry** (must be filled out and submitted exclusively by the College Director of Physical Education and Sports): Last date to send college entry through Google Form <https://forms.gle/LVoqTeoJHz5Yoe4h8> is **30/09/2026 latest by 10.00 a.m.**
- **Eligibility Proforma**: Participating teams must submit their eligibility proforma in Excel format via email to icteligibility@unigoa.ac.in no later than **30/09/2026 till 5.00 p.m.**

Health & Medical Safety Guidelines

- **Medical Fitness**: College Directors of Physical Education and Sports are responsible for ensuring all participants are fully fit. Goa University will not collect medical certificates, nor will it be held responsible for any medical complications that arise
- **First Aid**: Every participating team must carry their own dedicated first aid kit.
- The use of helmets is mandatory; however, an essential turban with proper folding is acceptable as a substitute for a crash helmet.
