NOTIFICATION

PG ADMISSION 2026-27 – COUNSELLING ROUND II

(For programmes offered both at University Schools and Colleges or at more than one Colleges)

The Second Round of Counselling for below mentioned programmes shall be conducted on 09th and 10th July 2026.

This Counselling Round is for the Candidates of GU-ART Round I who wish to transfer the seat or if a seat was not allotted and for those candidates who have answered GU-ART Round II 2026-27. The Schedule of Physical Counselling Round II is attached at Annexure I.

Round II Counselling shall be conducted for the following programmes:

NOTE:

- The Counselling for the Master of Laws programme shall be notified separately.
- Common Counselling shall be held for Master of Computer Application, M.Sc. Artificial Intelligence and M.Sc. Data Science.

Important Points:

- Seats shall be allotted based on Rank obtained by the Candidate in the concerned subject and seat availability.
- In case any Candidate from GU-ART Round I wishes to transfer the seat, for the above mentioned programmes, are required to be present for this Counselling Round.
- Counselling process shall be conducted in two sessions (Both the sessions will be held on same day) i.e. during Session 1, Vacant Reserved Category Seats shall be filled in session I. After conclusion of Session 1, vacant reserved category seats shall be transferred to the Un-Reserved Category. The Resultant vacancies shall be filled in Session 2. Resultant vacancies under Reserved Category i.e. vacant seats arising in the session 2 due to transfer of students from Reserved Category seat to Un-reserved Category, shall be filled in the subsequent round of Admission.

4. If a Candidate is not present when her/his name is announced, the seat available to her/him at that point in time shall be forfeited. If the candidate reaches late for the counselling session after her/his name is announced, the seat prevailing at that point in time shall be offered to her/him. The 1st seat shall be offered to the 1st rank holder. If the candidate who is ranked 1st is not present when her/his name is announced she/he will lose the chance to select the seat offered for that rank and the 2nd rank holder shall be offered the seat.

Example: If the 1st rank holder reaches late when counselling is in progress for the 15th seat, the 15th seat will be offered to him or her. If the candidate reaches after the completion of counselling, no seat shall be offered to her/him even if the candidate is ranked 1st.

No seat shall be allotted if candidate is absent for the counselling.

5. **Candidates are required to Carry the following Documents at the time of Counselling:**
 - i. Government issued Identity Proof/College Identity Card
 - ii. Valid Reservation Certificate (if applicable). If candidate fails to produce valid certificate than she/he shall be considered under Un-reserved category.
 - iii. OBC (non-creamy layer) Certificate is valid for three years from the date of issue. EWS Category Certificate shall be valid for one financial year. EWS and OBC (NCL) Category candidates are required to submit a valid certificate issued to that effect by the Officer of the rank of the Mamlatdar or any other Authorized Officer as notified by the Government of Goa.(If applicable)
 - iv. HSSC Marksheet and Undergraduate exam results (Semester I-V Marksheet, Semester VI Marksheet/printout of the Online Result)
 - v. Part C of the Admission Slip (Applicable to the candidates who have been allotted a seat in GU-ART Round I)
6. No proxy of the candidate shall be permitted without prior permission of the University Authorities. No parents/guardians will be permitted in the Counselling Hall.
7. Candidates are required to fill Part A of the Admission Slip (Enclosed) before the Counselling and submit it to the Counsellor at the time of Counselling.(For new candidates who have not been allotted a seat)

In addition to the above, candidates attending M.Sc. Chemistry Counseling shall be required to fill in the Preference Form provided indicating the choice of College/School and the choice of specialization (the Form shall be provided at the Counselling venue). Admission team will collect the form duly filled in when the particular candidate is called for counseling.

8. Part A and B of Admission slip shall be retained by the Counsellor and PART C of the Slip shall be issued to Candidates as a proof of allotment.
9. List of selected candidates of such programmes after the Counselling process shall be declared on the University website by 14/07/2026.
10. Selected Candidates shall be required to pay the seat confirmation fee of Rs. 10,000/- online on the SAMARTH Portal. The payment shall be accepted till 16/07/2026.

11. The seat confirmation fee of Rs. 10,000/- is **transferable**, if a candidate chooses to transfer from one programme to another and from one location to another in subsequent rounds. The fee is also **refundable**, within the 30 days from the last date of Admission, if a candidate is not admitted to the programmes **or** within 60 days from the last date of admission, if the candidate is unable to clear the qualifying examination.
12. Vacancies arising under the reserved category due to transfer/withdrawal/any other reason to be offered to the aspiring candidates of the same reserved category. If no reserved category candidates are available, then seats are to be opened and filled from the Unreserved Category based on the order of Rank.
13. All Candidates are required to wait till the end of the Counselling process. As any vacancy arising during the counselling will be offered to a candidate who has a higher rank, such a candidate's absence at the time vacancy is announced in the counselling process would lead to forgoing of that particular seat(s).
